### FEMA Job Fair Planned for Oct. 11 in Lahaina

A FEMA job fair will be held from **11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 11**, in Lahaina, where you can apply for a chance to join the team helping people before, during and after disasters.

The event will be held at the **Lahaina Civic Center Gymnasium at 1840 Honoapiilani Highway**.

FEMA has temporary vacancies for multiple positions on Maui and Oahu that start as 120-day appointments and may be extended up to one year. Benefits vary by position but include sick leave, health insurance and up to 11 paid holidays.

All applicants must be U.S. citizens, 18 years of age or older, and possess a high school diploma or General Equivalency Diploma. FEMA is an Equal Opportunity Employer.
