

MAUI HOTEL & LODGING ASSOCIATION 2017 SCHOLARSHIP

The Maui Hotel & Lodging Association (MHLA) scholarship program is designed to promote hospitality and culinary arts as a career and profession in Hawaii. The awards provide financial assistance to students who are currently attending University of Hawaii Maui College (UHMC) and have chosen a career path in the field of hospitality or culinary arts.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

Selection of the MHLA scholarship winners are based on a number of factors, with special emphasis on each individual's character, personal merit, and background. Merit is demonstrated in a variety of ways: leadership in school, community and extracurricular activities, academic achievement, and motivation to serve and succeed in all endeavors.

NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE: Six (6) scholarships of \$1,500 each, for a total of \$9,000

- Three (3) \$1,500 scholarships to UHMC Hospitality & Tourism students
- Three (3) \$1,500 scholarships to UHMC Culinary Arts students

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must:

- 1. Be enrolled as a student at UHMC (minimum of 9 credits)
- 2. Be working toward an Associate in Applied Science Degree in Hospitality & Tourism or Culinary Arts
- 3. Be a Hawaii resident and U.S. citizen
- 4. Have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale (official academic transcript must accompany application)

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Applicants must submit the following:

- 1. A completed MHLA application form
- 2. A personal statement that addresses the applicant's educational and career goals, co-curricular activities, commitment to serve Hawaii and its people, and work experience
- 3. One letter of recommendation attesting to applicant's character and potential
- 4. A resume
- 5. An official academic transcript

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Completed applications should be submitted to Lorelle Peros (Hospitality & Tourism Program Coordinator) or Teresa "Cheech" Shurilla (Culinary Arts Program Coordinator) by March 17, 2017.

NOTIFICATION:

Recipients will be notified of the award via mail. Scholarships may be redeemed through the MHLA office. Receipts may be submitted to:
