

2018 AOHT Alumni Scholarship Information

The Maui Hotel & Lodging Association's scholarship program is designed to promote the Visitor Industry as a career and profession in Hawaii; and to provide financial assistance to students whose chosen career path is within the Visitor Industry. The Scholarship Selection Committee grants preference to scholarship applicants who are alumni of the Academy of Hospitality & Tourism program and whose major post-secondary educational objective is within the Hospitality and Tourism Industry.

Scholarships Awards:

• \$500 - \$1,000

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants must be enrolled in a college or university and has completed the Academy of Hospitality & Tourism 2-year program at Baldwin, Lahainaluna or Maui High School.

Application Procedure - Applicants must submit each of the following documents in one complete packet – incomplete packets will not be accepted:

- Part I: A completed Maui Hotel & Lodging Association Scholarship Application Form
- Part II: A Personal Statement that addresses the applicant's educational and career goals, co-curricular
 activities, commitment to serve Hawaii and its people, and work experience
- Part III: **Two Letters of Recommendation** attesting to applicant's character and potential. Letters from family members will not be accepted.
 - 1. Instructor, Required
 - 2. Employer or an individual who made an impact on applicant's life
- Part IV: A Resume
- Part V: An official academic transcript

Scholarship Selection Committee:

The Selection Committee is comprised of industry and community representatives – all of whom have a vested interest in workforce development. The identity of the committee members will NOT be made public.

Application Deadline:

Completed applications must be delivered no later than 4 pm on Friday, March 30, 2018 or post-marked no later than Tuesday, March 27, 2018 to:
